How it works:

- Customer wears a wireless wrist band or pendant.
- When the button is pressed, an alert is sent to the 24/7 monitoring center.
- A specially trained attendant will attempt to make contact with the customer.
- The monitoring center will notify family or emergency personnel if needed.
